Objectives for the academic year (2021-22)

To deliver curriculum efficiently with the help of online platform:

The school believes that each child is unique and has to be groomed accordingly. So to handle the students more accurately and to deliver the curriculum effectively, the teachers were trained and various tools were introduced to deliver the teaching effectively. During the pandemic, the online platform was the only accessible tool to deliver the curriculum. So the teachers were acquainted with AI. to be used effectively to complement the teaching learning process. The objective was basically related to conceptual understanding and assessment of the same.

Teachers not only covered the scholastic areas but also the co-scholastic areas as well. Our Students responded well to online classes and have been getting their doubts cleared. Since the parents were kept in the loop from time to time, so they were well aware of how the school tried to cope up with the change. 96-98% students attended the online sessions. Only 2 to 4% students who were not able to attend the online session due to network issue or some medical reasons or some other valid reasons were supported through off-line medium. Doubt related sessions were arranged by the teachers for the students. Different activities were conducted to make the teaching learning process joyful. So in this academic session, the school has primarily been working in an online mood in accordance with the government regulations. Efforts were being made to ensure that all students actively participated in the online mode and ensured maximum learning outcomes.

Student Enrichment Programmes :

Like every year, this year too, the students actively participated in all school activities and competitions-but with a difference ,that is ,through virtual session,. These included poem recitation, drawing and poster making, greeting card making, compete in the pre-primary and primary sections.

All national, religious and regional festivals are held throughout the year to educate the children about the rich cultural and religious heritage of India and sensitise the students towards living in harmony in a diverse society and encourage them to pay respect to the customs and traditions of all religious communities. To promote various life skills and holistic development of the students, motivational lectures were organised. Art exhibition was held in the school which showcased the projects, models and other activities done by the students. Children presented their innovative ideas through best out of waste materials. Health

development was stressed upon, in association with focus on child abuse prevention. It included economic, psychological and legal aspect of child safety, gender equality and child rights call.

Promotion of sports and other co-curricular activities:

Along with academics, sports and Yoga are an integral part of school curriculum. Due to Covid school games tournaments were not organised. Students are motivated and guided to be physically fit and mentally alert. Yoga and meditation is an integral part of sports along with skating .

Teachers training and professional development:
